

IMPORTANT UPDATED NOTICE:

GENETIC TESTING AND VERIFICATION AT MMI GENOMICS

Please read the following carefully if you have used, anticipate using or continue to use MMI Genomics, Inc. ("New MMIG") in connection with any genetic testing or parentage verification.

1. New MMIG is a new entity or fictitious name affiliated with the purchaser of the assets of MMI Genomics, Inc. ("Old MMIG"), described further below.
2. The Association learned on April 25, 2011 that New MMIG does not, at this time, have a license to conduct the AM, NH, or CA genetic defect tests.
3. The Association currently has no contract with New MMIG to perform any authorized genetic defect or parentage testing.
4. New MMIG is the result of an asset sale affiliated with bankruptcy cases for Old MMIG and Metamorphix, Inc. the parent company to Old MMIG pending in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware ("Bankruptcy Court"). Some additional details include:
 - a. Metamorphix, Inc. became the subject of an involuntary bankruptcy action on January 28, 2010. On September 30, 2010, the Bankruptcy Court entered an order for relief placing Metamorphix into bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
 - b. On November 18, 2010, Old MMIG filed a voluntary Petition for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
 - c. On March 17, 2011, the Bankruptcy Court entered an Order approving the sale of substantially all of the Metamorphix and Old MMIG assets to Branhaven, LLC, as agent for certain parties. However, the Order and related Asset Purchase Agreement did not include any assumption or assignment of any contracts with the Association.
 - d. On April 20, 2011, the Bankruptcy Court entered orders converting the Metamorphix and Old MMIG cases to Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code.
5. Given these developments, the Association has determined to remove all references to Metamorphix and New or Old MMIG on this website.
6.
