(Minutes, pictures, agendas, reports, etc.) _____pts
 - C. Communication
(Newsletters, correspondence, web page, etc.) _____pts
 - D. Shows
(State shows, regional shows, NJAS, ROV shows, etc.) _____pts
 - E. Other Activities
(State, Regional, and National LEAD, field days, sales, fundraisers, etc.) _____pts
 - F. Honors and Awards
(Bronze, silver, and gold winners, state and national scholarship winners, state and national outstanding leadership awards, NJAS contest winners, etc.) _____pts
