

NJAA SWEEPSTAKES CONTEST

The NJAA Sweepstakes Contest was introduced at the 1992 National Junior Angus Show (NJAS) in Columbus, Ohio. This contest is designed to reward state junior associations for their members' participation in the various contests, exhibition of cattle and the National Junior Angus Showmanship Contest during the NJAS.

The contest will be split into 2 divisions based on the number of cattle actually checked in at the NJAS. The divisions are: 1) Less than 30 Head 2) 30 or more head.

Points are awarded based upon the placings of the individuals (or teams). In contests where there is more than one division, points will be awarded for each division. Points are awarded for the highest placing individual, team, or animal from each state in each of the contest categories. In the case of a tie, winner will be determined by number of events.

Point systems are as follows:
