ATLANTIC NATIONAL MERIT AWARD

The Atlantic National Angus Foundation sponsors a recognition program for junior members wishing to continue their education and in need of financial assistance. The award is based on the junior's involvement in the Angus industry, their communities and the Atlantic National Angus Show.

A qualified applicant must be a maximum of 25 years old as of January 1, 2009. The applicant must be a high school graduate or 2009 graduating senior in good standing, an active member of the National Junior Angus Association or American Angus Association and actively participate or exhibit at previous Atlantic National Angus Shows. Merit Award winners must be enrolled in some form of higher education, undergraduate or graduate level, or a vocational school within the current calendar year.

Applicants will be required to submit a resume, brief personal essay, and letter of recommendation. Finalists will be interviewed during the Atlantic National Friday, May 22, 2009. **Applicants must be present for award presentation** prior to selection of the Grand Champion Female on Sunday. **Application deadline is April 30, 2009.**

The top applicant will receive an additional award in memory of Greg Krueger, who passed away on November 4, 2001.
