Entry Deadline: May 1, 2010

Entry Fee: \$30.00/head

Bedding: Wood chips is provided. Any additional bedding material will be the exhibitor's responsibility.

Tie-outs: There is not a designated place for tie-outs so trailers are often used. No bedding is allowed in the parking lot.

Feed Store: A feed store is located across the street from the fairgrounds.

Health: Health certificates will be required on all out of state animals.

The plans for the 2010 Northwest Regional Preview Junior Angus Show on June 24-26 are coming together. This show will give you the opportunity to make new friends, renew old acquaintances and have a great time while exhibiting your Angus cattle. Please note all of the specific information for this show (the Northwest Regional Preview), in this section. You will also need to review the "general rules" section as they apply to all the shows listed in this packet.

This year's event will be in Prineville, Ore. at the Crook County Fairgrounds. The show will be held in conjunction with the Pacific International.

Please note that the applications for registration and transfer of ownership must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor and postmarked by May 1, 2010. If you are having problems getting your animals registered or transferred, please contact the American Angus Association two weeks prior to the ownership/transfer deadline. NO LATE REGISTRATIONS or TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE.

Entries must be completed online or postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than May 1, 2010. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED! The entry fee of \$30 per head must accompany the entry form.

NORTHWEST REGIONAL PREVIEW JUNIOR ANGUS SHOW

SHOW RULES

Show Categories:

1. There will be classes for bred-and-owned bulls, bred-and-owned heifers, heifers owned but not bred by exhibitor, steers and cow-calf pairs. Champions will be selected in each category. There will be no overall champion.
2. Entries will be listed in the catalog in order of age (youngest to oldest), and will be led into the showing in order of catalog number.
3. Classes will be made up after cattle have been checked-in at the show with no more than 15 head in any class. Most classes should have no more than a 30-day spread in age, and many may have only a few days spread. Classes will not be named, but should fall close to the standard classification in age breakdown.
4. Show classifications for heifers: September 1, 2008 through May 1, 2010**.
5. Show classifications for bulls: January 1, 2009 through May 1, 2010**.
6. Show classifications for steers: January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.

(**These are special age classifications for the Northwest Regional Preview ONLY**)

7. Any cow-calf pair may be exhibited provided the calf is bred-and-owned by the junior exhibitor and the following rules are met:
 - A. Cow must be bred-and-owned or solely owned by the exhibitor. If the cow was not bred by the exhibitor, the issue date on the recorded transfer of the cow must precede the breeding date of the cow for the calf at side.
 - B. Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and **must be born on or after September 18, 2009.**
 - C. Calf must be registered and tattooed by show date and have original registration paper.

There will be no separate division for bred-and-owned vs. owned cow-calf pairs.

Premiums & Awards:

1. Awards and premiums are being coordinated by the Northwest and Oregon Junior Angus Associations. Any questions regarding premiums or awards should be forwarded to the Oregon Junior Angus Association no later than six weeks after date of show. The show will also present premier exhibitor and outstanding Idaho junior herdsman awards.
2. Premier Breeder includes the three highest placing animals bred by a single breeder. Champions will be used only in the case of a tie. The winner, to be determined at the conclusion of the show, receives a silver tray. The American Angus Association sponsors this award.
