"Angus in the Heartland", held July 6-12 at the Indiana State Fairgrounds will be full of excitement and enthusiasm for Angus cattle and the National Junior Angus Association (NJAA). The Indiana Angus Associations have put in countless hours to make this year's event a great success.

The NJAS is much more than the world's largest single-breed beef show - it is the highlight of the year for the NJAA. The spotlight for the week is placed on the junior members as they participate in the cattle competition, the national showmanship contest and the various individual and state contests held throughout the week

Please note that the applications for early registration and transfer of ownership must be recorded in the sole name of the exhibitor and postmarked by May 15, 2014. If you don't have registration papers on newly purchased animals in your hands two weeks prior to the ownership/transfer deadline for a particular show, please contact the American Angus Association. NOTE: OWNERSHIP AND ENTRY DEADLINE: MAY 15. NO LATE REGISTRATIONS/TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE.

Entries must be postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than May 15, 2014. The entry fee of \$60 per head must accompany the entry form. Late Entries may be completed ONLINE ONLY from May 16 - 25, 2014. The entry fee will be \$100/head for late entry. Ownership deadline is May 15. Entry fee includes the bedding in the barns and tie-outs. A portion of the entry fee goes into the premiums account of the American Angus Association used to pay a small part of the NJAS premiums. The remainder of the entry fee is the cost of the bedding for both in the barns and in tie-outs.

Please note all of the specific information for this show (the NJAS), in this section. You will also need to review the "general rules" section as they apply to all the shows listed in this packet.

The 2014 NJAS planning committee will be providing a portion of the meals during the NJAS this summer. In order to get a more accurate count for the caterer of the number of meals to be served and to make adequate meal arrangements we ask that you complete the meal portion of the entry when submitting your entries. Please take into consideration all family members, grandparents, friends, fitters and other guests that may be with you at the show. A \$20 one-time family fee is asked for contibution to meals.
