If you are having problems getting your animals registered or transferred, please contact the American Angus Association two weeks prior to the ownership/transfer deadline. NO LATE REGISTRATIONS or TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE.

Entries must be completed on-line or postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than May 1, 2018. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED! The entry fee of \$45 per head must accompany the entry form.
