Summer Show Season Changes

No Fit Show: This will be a "Blow and Go" show. Grooming or fitting with foreign material that includes (but not limited to) painting, powdering, oiling, artificial coloring, or adhesives is prohibited. Non-aerosol sheen is allowed. Going to this format will eliminate the need for more help during the show and allow for more social distancing.

Stalling: Exhibitors will be stalled as a family with appropriate distance between tack areas.

Ring side spectators: Ring side seats will be limited. Spectators will be encouraged to watch the show via webcasted screens throughout the grounds or online.
