

# AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION® Highlights of the Meetings of the Board of Directors November 5 and 8, 2021

The following is a review of the topics discussed and action taken during the meetings of the Board of Directors held November 5 and 8, 2021, in Fort Worth, Texas.

- Pam Velisek, President of the American Angus Auxiliary, gave an overview of the Auxiliary's activities of the past year.
- The 2021 annual report and fiscal year (FY) 2021 finances were reviewed. Chuck Grove moved, seconded by Barry Pollard, to accept the report. The motion was unanimously approved.
- The Member Services Committee met on October 28, 2021 via Zoom.
  - The gene edit policy was reviewed. Mick Varilek moved, seconded by Richard Dyar, to
    present a minor revision to the policy to the Association Board for discussion. The motion

- Timeline and subsequent updates to Maternal Weaned Calf Value (\$M) and (Combined Value) \$C were discussed.

- An update was provided regarding the previously approved purchase by Certified Angus Beef LLC of a farm property that will serve to expand educational efforts and build on the value of the CAB® Culinary Center.
