## CHECK-IN TIME: 1:00 to 3:00 PM on Mon, Jan. 5<sup>th</sup>.

We will check in by pen, starting with the alley closest to the Performance Arena. A regional manager will dismiss you.

**LOCATION:** TBD until staff arrive.

## CHECK-IN PROCESS:

- ◆ Bring original registration papers and the animals to the check-in area.
- ◆ Association staff will provide each cattle handler an animal ID card to him/her before entering the chute. *Please read and correct any information on the card.*
- ◆ Tattoos, EID tags or freeze brands (permanent identification marks) and papers will be checked on all animals.
- ◆ Tattoo/EID (or other accepted permanent identification mark) must be legible and match the registration paper.
- ◆ Scrotal measurements will be taken on all bulls.
- ◆ All animals will be ultra-sounded.
- ◆ *Exhibitors must designate the alternate heifers/bulls for each pen at check-in time.* All pens must be designated during the check – in time to the superintendents on Monday. Note the rules on alternates from the premium book.

*All Angus entries are subject to provisions of the rules of the American Angus Association. Exhibitors must designate alternate heifers/bulls (no more than*

*two) at check-in to the American Angus Association pen and carload superintendent.*

*If an alternate is to be used, following check-in, it can only be done in the case of death, unsoundness, or sickness. This must be approved one hour before the time of the show, by the Association superintendent. The decision of the superintendent will be final.*

**EXHIBITOR NUMBERS:** By Thursday afternoon, each exhibitor will receive a copy of the class breaks and an exhibitor number "back tag" for each pen in the show.

## SHOW DAY:


- ◆ All pens will be weighed prior to entering the ring and average weights will be calculated.
- ◆ No coloring agents are allowed.
- ◆ No aerosols are allowed after the heifer/bulls cross the scales.
- ◆ Exhibitors are responsible to get to the scales and line up for their class(es) when directed by Association staff.

## HERDSMAN OF THE YEAR:

- ◆ Votes must be cast online by Thursday, January 8<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 PM. All eligible voters will have received an email.
